THE HYDROGRAPHIC SOCIETY: SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

1. The scholarship is available to any full-time first-year, second-year or later students who are currently enrolled in a Hydrographic, Geomatic, Ocean Sciences or Geographic Information Science degree program and can demonstrate an interest in marine or offshore survey, mapping or positioning.
2. Applicants must be currently resident in Texas or plan on attending a college in Texas.
3. First-year students who qualify will receive a \$500 scholarship award for the first year and will be given preference in future scholarship applications from the THSOA - Houston Chapter.
4. Second-year and higher students who qualify will receive a \$2,000 scholarship award.
5. Second-year and higher students must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
6. The student must complete an application form and a short essay (no more than 2000 words) that describes the student's interest in offshore surveying, positioning or mapping.
7. All applications must be accompanied by a recommendation from a member of the high school or college faculty.
8. Applications will be reviewed by the Membership/Student Liaison Committee Member for the Houston Chapter of the THSOA and forwarded with a recommendation to the full committee.
9. The Chapter would encourage scholarship awardees to give a brief presentation (5 - 10 minutes) at a Houston Chapter meeting at a mutually convenient date. The student would be expected to outline their career interest in ocean sciences, hydrographic surveying, offshore mapping or positioning.

THE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD WILL BE BASED ON THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- Faculty review and recommendation
- Membership/Student Liaison Committee Member review and recommendation
- THSOA – Houston Chapter Committee review and recommendation
